"16th CENTURY EYEWITNESS TESTIMONIES OF SPANISH EXPEDITIONS IN THE UNITED STATES " JANUARY PROGRAM OF THE HSEH

Steven Strange, an Associate Member of the North American Academy of the Spanish Language, and Vice-president of the Historical Society of East Hartford, will give a presentation on eyewitness testimonies from 16th century Spanish expeditions and voyages in what is currently the United States. His presentation will stress the first descriptions of the terrain, physical features, flora and fauna, and Native Americans as perceived by the Spaniards. Be prepared to be transported to the North America of almost five hundred years ago, and almost a hundred years before the founding of Jamestown in 1607. And as Walter Cronkite would say... While Steven will be dressed in 16th century attire, he will give the presentation in English.
